

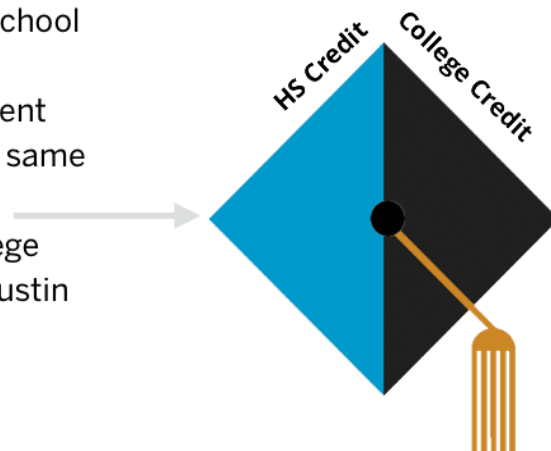
University of Texas – Austin: OnRamps Dual Enrollment Program

What is OnRamps?

- Dual Enrollment, NOT Dual Credit
- 2 teachers (one from BHS and one UTA professor)
- 2 grades (BHS high school grade and UTA transcript grade)

The OnRamps Model:

- A yearlong University of Texas at Austin designed college experience, in a high school classroom
- Students engage with high-quality content and build digital literacy skills using the same tools as UT students
- Opportunity to earn three hours of college credit from The University of Texas at Austin



Advantages of this program:

- Access: Provides UT-Austin experience on the Burleson High School campus
- Transferability: Guaranteed transfer to public colleges and universities in Texas and beyond
- Flexibility: Students are exempt from TSI requirements
- Saves money: Provides UT-core courses at 75% off the cost for the same course taken on campus
- Preparation: Students gain early exposure to college expectations, easing the transition from high school to college

Courses available for the 2017-18 school year:

- PreCalculus (MATH 2312)
- English IV (ENG1301/ENG1302)

Tuition and Fees:

- Tuition: \$295 per course/\$75 per course (F/R)
- Textbooks- no cost
- Deadline to submit names through Google Doc: Friday, June 19, 2017

Transferability of credit:

- Courses are part of the university's core curriculum and are guaranteed to transfer to any other public college or university in Texas

Who is eligible?

- For the 2017-18 school year, only seniors will be considered for the English course. Students who as received an 80% or higher in Algebra 2 are eligible for Precalculus.
- This course would replace the traditional English 4 or Dual Credit English Course (1301/1302). Credit cannot be given for both.

How do I sign up for the program?

- There will be a Google Doc sign up form on the BHS website starting on June 12.
- In the event that the number of students wishing to take the course exceeds the allowable number of seats, a lottery will be held to determine who will be admitted and a waitlist will be implemented.
- Please sign up even if you are uncertain; there is no commitment until August.
