Goal 1: We will design an engaging and challenging curriculum that develops each student's ability to read, write, think, and defend.

Performance Objective 1: BHS will increase by at least 5 percentage points the number of students performing at "meets grade level" in all tested content areas for all student groups.

Performance Objective 2: BHS will meet all system safeguards achieving 65% of students "Approaching Grade Level" on STAAR/EOC for the LEP, SPED, AA and Economically Disadvantaged students groups in the areas of English and Math.

Goal 2: We will provide students with multiple avenues for specialized instruction and opportunities to advance at their own pace.

Performance Objective 1: BHS will provide opportunities for students to take increased advanced coursework.

Performance Objective 2: BHS will meet all Domain 3 (closing the gaps) student group standards.

Goal 3: We will equip teachers with the resources, training, and time necessary to achieve our strategic objectives.

Performance Objective 1: 100% of BHS professional development will be aligned to the district's expectations and state and federal requirements.

Performance Objective 2: BHS will ensure that 100% of teachers meet certification/qualified status including those positions hired under the BISD "District of Innovation Plan".

Goal 4: We will establish a culture at BHS that intentionally prepares students for future endeavors, including college, workplace, and the military.

Performance Objective 1: The BHS Campus will increase the number of students that are CCMR (College, Career, and Military Ready) by 5% points for 9th grade, 10% points for 10th grade and 15% points for both 11th and 12th grade by EOY 2019.

Performance Objective 2: BISD will increase by 5% the number of students across all student groups earning scores of 3, 4, or 5 on Advanced Placement examinations.

Performance Objective 3: BISD will ensure that 100% of middle and high school students, teachers, counselors and parents are provided information regarding higher education information strategies as well as career and technical education (CTE) options for all students.

Goal 5: We will offer educational programs of choice that will nurture students' unique talents and promote global

citizenship.

Performance Objective 1: BHS will provide clear pathways of articulation for students involved in programs and schools of choice.

Goal 6: We will employ effective and efficient processes systems for student safety, attendance, and discipline.

Performance Objective 1: BHS will reduce the difference between All Student and Special Education student placements in DAEP, In-School Suspensions, and Out-of-School Suspensions to a disproportionality rate of less than 10% when compared to the rate for All Students.

Performance Objective 2: BHS will ensure that all campuses follow Board policies FFI (LEGAL) and FFI (LOCAL) with regard to bullying prevention, identification, response, and reporting.

Performance Objective 3: BHS will ensure that all students have access to resources to support social and emotional health through counseling services and campus nurses.

Performance Objective 4: BHS will ensure that the district realizes a measurable improvement in the graduation rate and dropout rate on the campus.
